

Course Player Overview

Once you've located your course in the LMS, click the course title or play icon to launch the course player. Before the course begins, you'll go through a few preliminary steps. This guide will walk you through those steps and highlight key features and functions of the course player.

Starting Your Course

 a. If applicable, you will see the jurisdiction Course Credit Confirmation screen. Click SHOW ME ALL REGULATORS.



 The applicable regulator for the course will appear on screen along with any required reporting fields for the course. Once you have filled them out, please click SUBMIT & CONTINUE.


Note: The reporting field refers to any information we collect from you at the course launch to report credits or completion data after finishing the course.

"I acknowledge that the name provided is correct and that I will no longer be able to change my profile name."


Please read through the information on this page carefully, then select the radio button to confirm and click **Next** to continue.





Function Description

- **6. Gear** The **gear** icon allows you to adjust the volume of the narration. You can also turn on your speaker or headset.




7. Left Arrow


The **left arrow** allows you to maximize the course player by closing the course details.

Glossary – When expanded, this button shows the key terms and definitions in the course.




Course Materials – When expanded, this button displays the materials related to the course that you may use or download.
